I only learned recently of Al's passing into Glory from receiving your letter last week that it was May 1<sup>st</sup> 2018. I must tell you up front that of the many Christian writers and the many friends and associates that have influenced my life through their Books, Articles and Social Media contacts, Al's influence for my spiritual welfare and growth in The Lord, his was second only to the Holy Spirit and the faithful witness of men of God of the same cut of cloth who have gone on ahead and await with Al to be raised incorruptible and receive Glorified bodies at the Rapture. Knowing that we who may remain alive until that time will be caught up together with him and all the Saints and be with the Lord forever we are greatly comforted. (I Thessalonians 4:13-18).

I never made personal contact with Al, but through the many Media Spotlight Journals and his Books I've read through the years, I feel he and I were kindred spirits in the Lord and in the work of the ministry, especially with a discernment gift and desire to see the Truth in the Light of the rightly divided word of Truth properly viewing the Media World through its lens in such a way that timely articles made available to the Body of Christ would edify the Believer and keep their proverbial feet to the fire of Truth.
